I also understand that all horses and ponies are powerful and could be dangerous to me or to others that are on, near, or around them.

I understand that anyone riding, driving, working with, handling, or near a horse or pony can suffer bodily and other injuries. The stable, trainer, and the owners of the land cannot guarantee my safety.
